

**BIO**

**Dancer and performance artist Heike Langsdorf** (1974, Burghausen) lives and works in Brussels. She studied Contemporary Dance at the Conservatory Arnhem (NL), (today: [ArtEZ](#)) and the postmaster-program Advanced Performance Training ([a.pass](#)) at Antwerp. She worked for and with various theatre makers, choreographers, visuals artists and architects, amongst whom Jan Fabre, Kris Verdonck, Davis Freeman, Alexander Baervoets, Ula Sickle, Krisztina De Chatel, Karin Post, Lilia Mestre, Einat Tuchman, Vermeir and Heiremans, Laurent Liefooghe, Bauke Lieven & Wouter De Raeve. For twelve years she formed, together with Christophe Meierhans and Christoph Ragg, the collective *C&H*. Together, they developed and presented performances and performative frameworks in which they explored the conditions for action inside and outside the theatre- and art-context. Since 2010 she produces—continuously shifting functions as maker, performer, curator, artistic researcher and pedagogue—her own work under the umbrella of *radical\_hope*. Between 2016 and 2019 Langsdorf was KAAP-maker, artist in residence at [KAAP Creative Compass](#). From 2020 on KAAP supports her long term project *radical\_house*.

The most recent performances created with *radical\_hope* are: [Sitting With The Body 24/7](#) (2015), [InCompany Workers Club](#) (2016 i.c.w. Einat Tuchman, Nicolas Galeazzi), [Mount Tackle](#) (2016/17) / [Revisited](#) (2019), [Un/Settled Residency & The Library is Calling](#) (2018 i.c.w. Ernst Maréchal) and [...Through Practices](#) (2019).

Langsdorf works at [KASK - school of arts HOGENT](#) as a teacher, mentor, coach and since 2016 researcher. From 2016 until 2019 was running the research-project [Distraction as Discipline](#) in association with Anna Luyten and in this context closely collaborating with Alex Arteaga, Tawny Andersen and Anouk Llaurens. In the winter 2019 she closed this trajectory with [Two Frameworks](#), the symposium ... *Through Practices* and *Mount Tackle (Revisited)*.

Throughout the years Langsdorf worked and works in dialogue with dramaturges, editors and producers as Sébastien Hendrickx (2012-14), Jeroen Peeters (2014/15), Kristof Van Baarle (2016/17), Elowise Vandenbroecke (2017/19) and Simone Basani (2020-).

Parallel to making artistic work Heike Langsdorf has always been developing a discursive practice. Together with Ernst Maréchal she recently contributed to *a/r revue*—a platform for the promotion of artistic research—with an article titled [How Do We Do It Exactly Now?](#) to *A/R International Journal* with [With \(Violent\) Love](#): The first is a contemplation on [How Do We Do It?](#)—a platform for arts and design research practices that is a framework for sharing practices as research processes, initiated by her, Alex Arteaga and a group of colleagues at KASK. The second, commissioned Rudi Laermans & Karin Hannes is exposing the often praised characteristics of artists—not-knowing, failing and fainting—as rather merciless selfconfronting qualities. Langsdorf is together with Alex Arteaga co-editor of the book series *Choreography as Conditioning* (launch of completed series planned for the fall 2020). The writings of this series are rooted in a cycle of work sessions entitled [CASC at KASK](#), in which students work together with Langsdorf and invited guests. They the notions of choreography, understood as ways of organising subjects in their surroundings, and conditioning in both art-making and society-making.

#### **From *radical\_hope* to *radical\_house***

In 2010 *radical\_hope* acted as the title for the research-project of performance artist Heike Langsdorf at [a.pass](#). Meanwhile it developed into a working attitude supporting her various distinct practices. This work ethics is allowing to resist the constant call for art being explicitly political, societal relevant and socially engaged. There is an attempt to work without a pre-set conception of both the kind of artistic task that will be fulfilled, what the work could mean within the artistic career, and a discourse produced to date. >

> Alternately, radical\_hope is about embracing the in situ context as a point of departure and supporting the imagination of ‘what can happen’ from there on. The etymology of the word ‘radical’ is to be traced back to the Latin word ‘radix’ meaning ‘a root’. Accordingly, radical\_hope is about grounding the artistic work in something tangible: the very context — in which the works take place — is embraced as a given and forms the departure point. This requires an in situ approach in which the surrounding environment undergoes as little manipulation as possible. Radical\_hope is a way of working that challenges a context from an artistic point of view without diminishing its natural complexity.

With radical\_hope and usually in co-creation with others, Heike Langsdorf generates environments, spaces and situations in which we get a sense for the potential to shape things ourselves and experience the success and failure that goes with it as something tangible. Within a world that compulsively calls for attention and participation, attention and participation is claimed as something we can shape ourselves. The public is invited to find their own way of viewing, interpreting and ‘dealing with things’. radical\_hope is about enabling engagement, not ordering it.

Currently Langsdorf is developing on radical house, moving from her working ethics *radical\_hope* to a new framework: presenting a long term project of a threefold nature it presents a physical place, a framework and a logic which she is developing in dialogue with Miriam Rohde, Simone Basani and Hans Bryssinck. When in 2013 teaching and mentoring became an extension of Langsdorf's artistic practices now *radical\_house* stems from her pedagogical experience where 'being in dialogue' with others is her main principle.
